### **Our goal is simple...**

We want to prevent students from falling out of their education and if they already have, we want to inspire them back to their learning.

We know that some children do not learn well in a conventional classroom. This is often due to learning difficulties, environmental factors and the lack of role models. These children will become restless and disruptive. We want to give these children the opportunity to learn in a different way. We want to arm them with the strategies and skills to flourish with their learning.

We support these students by providing funding for a selection of re-engagement courses depending on their age.

These courses allow students to 'breathe'.

In the confines of the classroom, disengaged students will struggle to deal with the pressures of mainstream education. However, in the surroundings of the Oxfordshire woodland, where our courses take place, they are able to calm themselves, gain a perspective on what they are trying to achieve and build their self esteem.

Without intervention many of these children will slip away into a world without any education.

Intervention means money.
